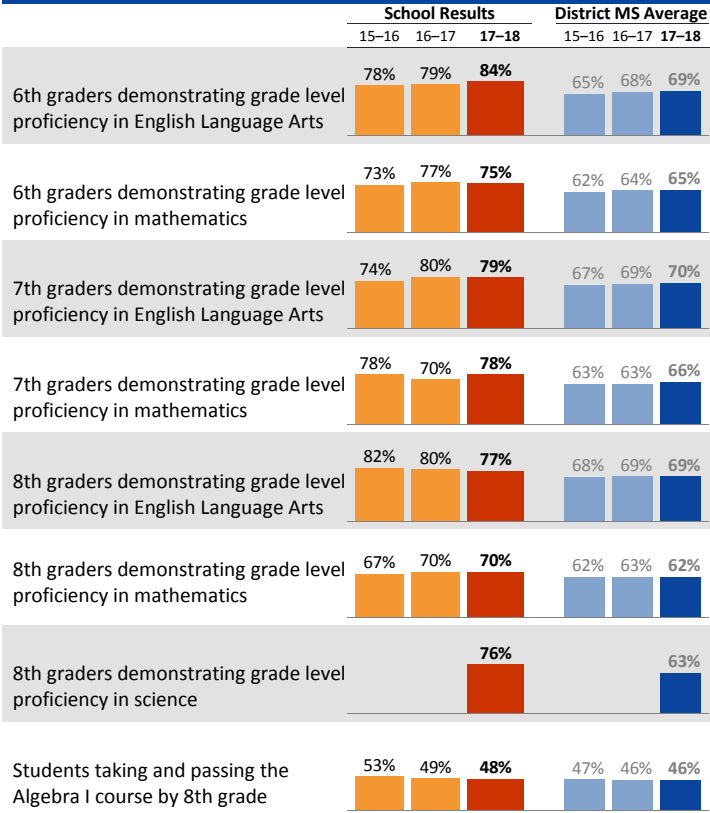

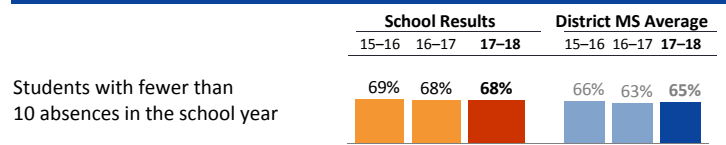

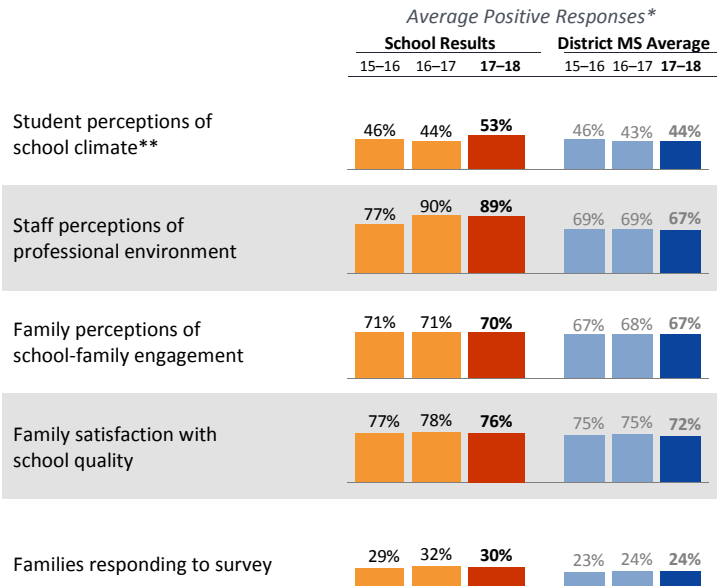

### Attendance

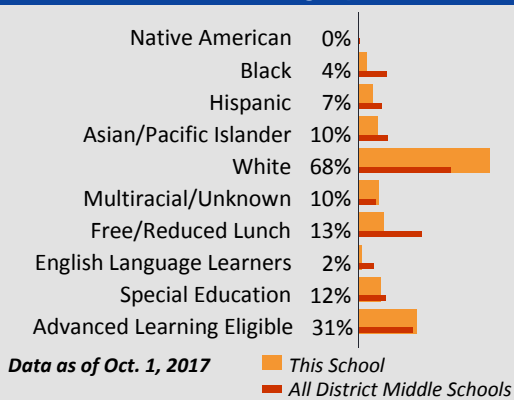


### Student, Family, and Staff School Climate Survey

**School Mission Statement**

**School Goals**

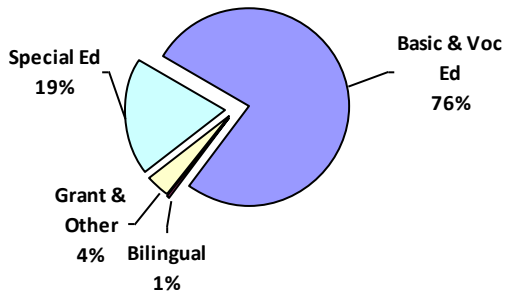
- 70% of Students receiving a Level 1 and Level 2 on the State reading assessment (SBA) will meet or exceed standard
- 70% of reading and/or math Level 1 and Level 2 students will have fewer than 10 days of absences (excused + unexcused)
- 80% of African American students will meet or exceed proficiency standard on the state reading assessment.
- 100% of students will positively identify an adult within the building who cares and checks in on them regularly.

**School Description & Plan to Achieve Goals**

Eckstein Middle School is located in Northeast Seattle and serves students in 6-8th grade. The current enrollment is 1037 students. Eckstein is a comprehensive middle school offering students in-depth hands-on science experiences and math courses, including Algebra and Geometry. In addition to core content classes, Eckstein provides students with a wide variety of electives including orchestra, band, choir, art, technology, PE and an award winning Jazz program. World languages including French, Spanish and Japanese are also part of the curriculum. Eckstein is known for its inclusive special education program with a broad spectrum of services. We offer grade level field trips that include Camp Orkila, Tillicum Village and multiple Seattle venues. Eckstein is also committed to nurturing all students and to this end provides mentoring programs, Academic Intervention Services, afterschool programming, lunch clubs and a variety of ways for students to engage in small groups.
