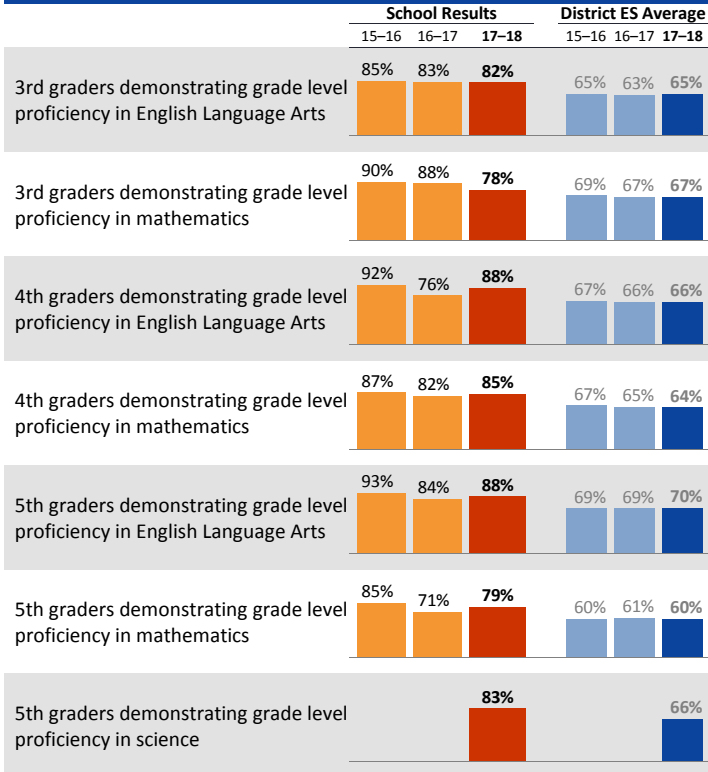

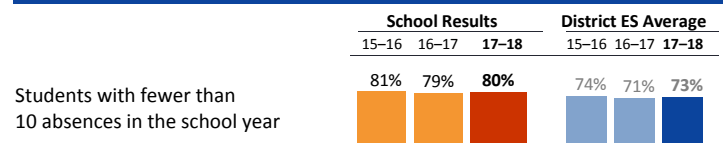

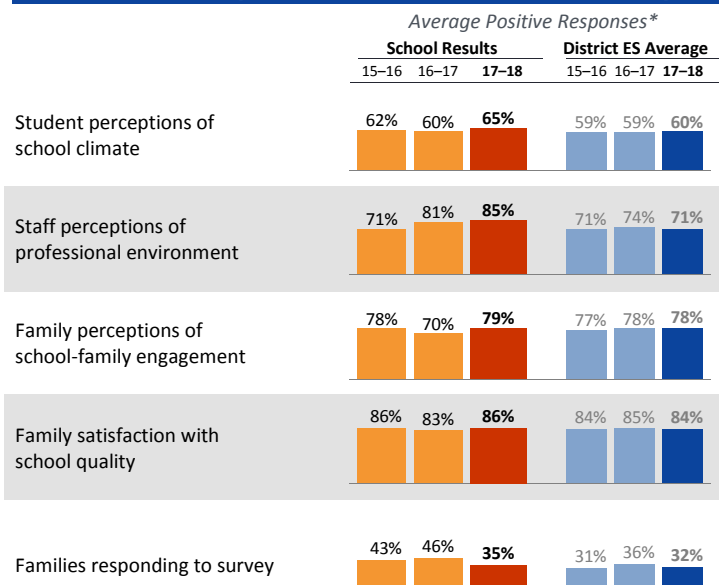

### Attendance

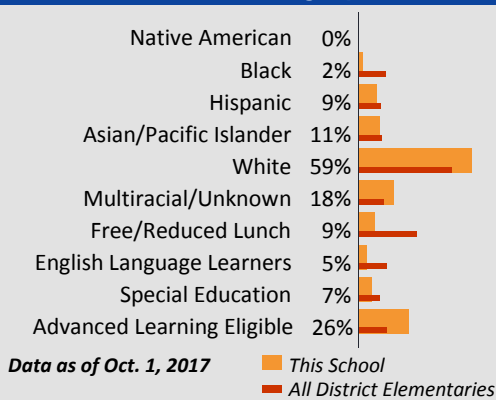


### Student, Family, and Staff School Climate Survey

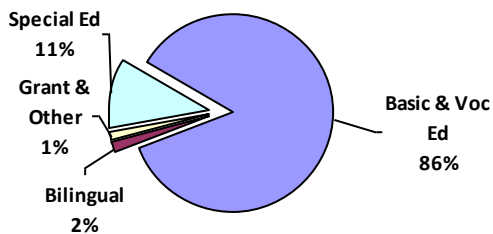
**School Mission Statement** Wedgwood is an inclusive community of responsible, caring citizens dedicated to students achieving their full potential.
